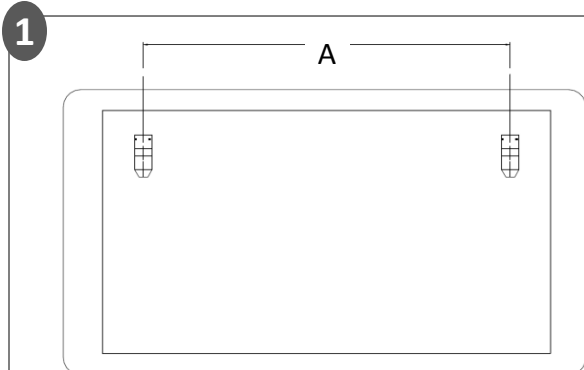
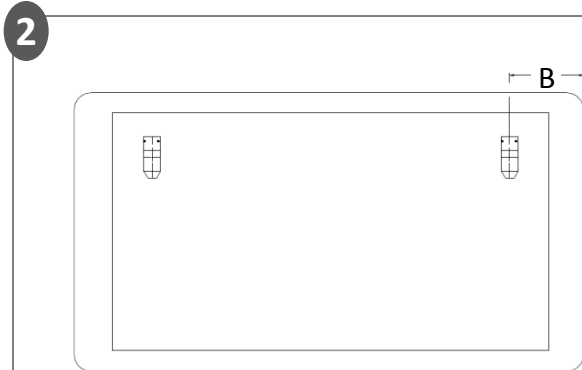


# Heated Mirror with Light – Installation Instructions

(Models MLD 600 / MLD 900 / MLD 1200)



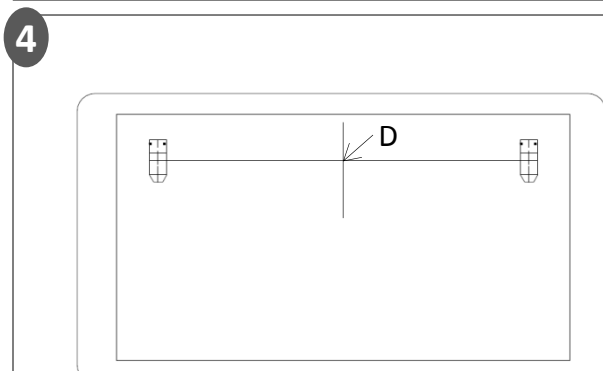
Measure the distance between the two brackets on the mirror



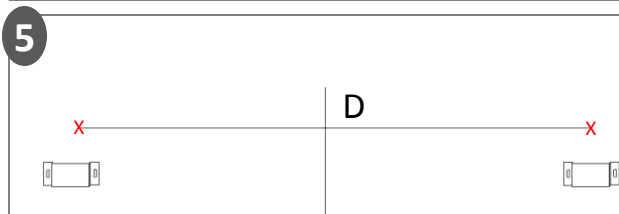
Measure the distance between the edge of the mirror and the centre of the bracket.



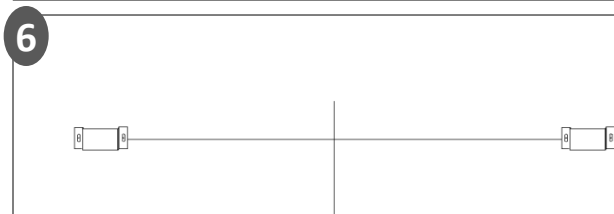
Measure the distance between the top line of the mirror and the centre of the bracket



Mark the centre point on the wall.



Using Point D calculate the centre of each of the mirror brackets on the wall.



Place the brackets on the centre point and mark the shape of the bracket on the wall. Then mark the screw holes on the wall. Fix the wall brackets and hang the mirror.

### Features

Built-in light • Built-in Demister • Electronic touch pad for On/Off control • Can be hardwired or plug-in installation

### Installation

Ensure that the electricity supply is disconnected from any relevant fixed wiring before commencing the installation. Ensure that the mains supply voltage is as stated on the rating label. The supply circuit must be adequate for the input of the appliance. **This unit must be installed by a registered electrician.** The installation of this product must comply with NZS 3000.2007. Do not attempt to repair the heated mirror or unscrew the outer casing yourself. **This unit must be earthed.**

### Operating Instructions

- When the power is connected, the red lamp turns on.
- Touch the highlighted square on the mirror below the red lamp. The light will turn green indicating that the heater and the mirror light are on.

### Safety

- This heated mirror has been designed and manufactured to the highest international standard, but, like all other electrical appliances which are operated by mains voltage, care must be taken if you are to obtain the best results and safety is to be assured.
- This heated mirror is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instructions concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the mirror.
- The heated mirror is to be installed so that switches and other controls cannot be touched by a person in the bath or shower.
- The heated mirror must not be installed in front of a socket-outlet.
- Means for disconnection must be incorporated in the fixed wiring in accordance with the wiring rules.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- Do not handle the heated mirror with wet hands.
- The supply cord on this heated mirror can only be replaced by the use of special tools, and should any damage or fault occur to the heated mirror, it must be serviced by an accredited service agent.

### Product Warranty – 2 year warranty

Any heated mirror that is found to be defective due to substandard materials and/or workmanship within 2 (two) years from the date of purchase, will be replaced. To make a claim under this warranty, contact the store where you purchased your product.

Your claim will be assessed based on the information you provide. You will be required to return the defective product for assessment at your cost. The warranty does not cover any installation or removal costs. The benefits given by this warranty are additional to other rights and remedies that you may have under laws relating to our products.

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the New Zealand/Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.

- The warranty does not extend to any consequential loss, damage, misuse, neglect, alteration or incorrect installation.
- Attach your proof of purchase and keep it in a safe place with this warranty form. You must have your proof of purchase for your warranty to be valid.
